Project Description

This project is based on ideas such as:

- awareness of the great importance of volunteering for a prosperous society;
- getting acquainted with the different types of volunteering and their dimensions; - generating ideas for the future activities and laying the foundations for their implementation. With the implementation of the project will be achieved the following objectives: rediscovering volunteering as a starting point for personal and professional development for young people
- creating opportunities for young people to become active citizens of their society through volunteer initiatives - awareness of the importance of young people for the community and their power to change the world

- providing a basis for transforming young people into active and informed citizens
 - helping to improve the key skills and competencies of young people
- goals, a major role is expected to be played by the partner organization, which has significant experience in volunteering activities, both nationally and internationally, in working with Turkish organizations. The experience that the partner organization has will be extremely useful and valuable for the successful implementation of the project. The young participants in the project have experience in volunteering, but they also have desire to learn more about it as a form of self-expression and personal development.

MANAGEMENT

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The sending countries are responsible for the voluntary coaching of the departure, taking into account the specific ones needs of the participants, for example, poor language skills, social challenges, etc. Transmitting agencies are supported by volunteers who prepare in advance, are responsible for voluntary applications for insurance and travel arrangements and visa application assistance. The home of the volunteers in Primorsko Bulgaria will have all the necessary conditions to ensure their good condition and safety.

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This will help better cooperation between volunteers and the hosting organization and will enrich their volunteering experience. Monitoring: a meeting at the end of each month, the coordinator will constantly monitor their work and will give feedback. They will insure the sending organization. Our team has experience in working with young people and dealing with the crisis every day and overcoming them more or less technically /professional way, depending on the dimension of the crisis. All volunteers will meet with their mentor weekly to present any difficulties / challenges he / she may face. The trip - arrival and departure of volunteers will be organized by themselves with the support and assistance of the project coordinator and the sending organization. For safety and security - these are very important principles are the responsibility of our safety manager, who will provide support and all information about standard procedures, contact numbers, etc. encouraged, for the activities they perform, vital and working environment, as well as constructive feedback and mutual dialogue. We will provide them with emergency contacts: Number of mentors; The number of supervisors and the number of the chairman, and for their safety connects with the police, etc. We expect strong support from sending organizations and regular maintenance communication via e-mail, skype, telephone and social networks from the preparation stage, as well as during and after the volunteer service and after the volunteers returned home. Adaptation in the city For better adaptation, the volunteer(s) will have orientation with other local volunteers upon arrival. Volunteers will receive a city map, vocabulary and an intensive language course and will be enrolled in training on arrival. Risk prevention After the arrival of volunteers, members of the organization will instruct volunteers on safety measures for work and office equipment, and will provide volunteers with information about the possible risks that may occur. They will get an emergency telephone number of one of the members of the organization so that he can ask for help in any situation. The members of the organization have experience in resolving various crisis situations and especially for preventing them before they even appear. Another aspect of crisis management will be the support of mentor and supervision. Volunteers are shopping for groceries, and menus and shopping are being done

The activities that will be carried out within the project

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Project activities are based on non-formal education and are selected in such a way as to contribute to achieve the overall objectives of the project. Each activity is logically related to the next and leads to upgrading what has already been achieved. Through cognitive activities, ice breaking games and building games of a team in the first days of the project aims to get to know the participants and achieve a pleasant working environment, which will contribute to increasing solidarity between young people and a desire to work together. The participants will

have the opportunity to learn more about the concept of volunteering, they will realize what it is like to be a citizen closely associated with public ills, they will realize that volunteering is an appropriate and very good way to express an active citizenship. Through this, young people will realize the importance of being active volunteers and striving to be better European citizens citizens

Preparation and information for the selection of participants for youth exchange:

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All participants in the project will be sent in advance an info package and a program that will be able to navigate and prepare for discussed topics and lectures. Skype will be held so that you can ask questions and find answers. Online channel will be created in the WhatsApp application, which will have a chat with mentors and participants. Each participant will be pre-authorized and is encouraged to develop a more appropriate topic for participation.

Transport details, the budget, the reimbursement method and the arrival and departure dates will be clearly communicated so that the participants can decide in advance the best ways to travel to the exchange location. The project team will prepare an informative document for group leaders and participants with location and contact numbers, modes of transport to the location and any other useful information about the nearby area (for example: emergency telephone numbers, location of the nearest pharmacy, location of the nearest hospital, taxi numbers, how to make a return, etc.)

The creation of agreements with partners will be done virtually, via email or video communication. We will agree objectives, division of logistics tasks and the general content of the exchange. Quality will be guaranteed when using different types of project management and planning tools. These methods will first be discussed with partners and agreed. In the selection Potential participants will prepare a Europass CV and provide information on a training agreement.

Preparation and support of participants:

participants must receive appropriate preparation in terms of practical, cultural and safety aspects. They should be fully aware of what is expected from them before, during and after the activity. Adequate guidance and support must be available during all phases of the activities.
